Directions from Fort Worth area: (approx. 45 minute drive from Benbrook)

From either Loop 820 W southbound or I20 westbound, exit HW 377 South / Granbury Follow 377 to Granbury \sim 20 miles

Pass thru "retail row" (Starbucks on your left!), then exit to 144 (Glen Rose on sign) Turn RIGHT at the top of the ramp, then immediately LEFT at light on FM51 / Paluxy HW

Follow FM 51 South approx. 4 miles, park in open lot at Brushy Road intersection
